

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) following a death.

1. How can I arrange a stone setting?

Please phone Liberal Judaism on 020 7631 9822. They will also be your contact for agreeing a date with one of our rabbis. You may find it useful to know that a stone setting usually takes place at least 9 months after the funeral, to allow the ground to settle.

3. The funeral was a cremation. How can I arrange a suitable ceremony for burying or scattering the ashes?

- *There are various options following a cremation in which to commemorate someone at either Golders Green Crematorium or Edgwarebury Cemetery in Edgware.*
- *For Golders Green Crematorium, contact them directly on 020 8455 2374.*
- *At Edgwarebury Cemetery, it is possible to have a cremation stone or alternatively a rose bush. Phone Alex Simonon at Liberal Judaism on 020 7631 9822 for further information.*
- *Regarding a ceremony, please make contact with the synagogue office on 01923 822592.*

4. How can I ensure the synagogue can mark the anniversary of the death during the appropriate shabbat services? (Yahrzeit)

We keep a Yahrzeit database in the synagogue office which enables us to remind you a few weeks ahead of the week-end in which the Yahrzeit occurs. If you would like to take advantage of this facility, please call the synagogue office, with the details, on 01923 822592.

5. How can I arrange for the name of the deceased to be read out in the next Yom Kippur Memorial service?

Complete and return the form, which all members receive with their High Holyday tickets, in which you can give details of the names of the deceased who have died in the preceding year.

6. How can I have a leaf in the Synagogue's Tree of Remembrance, situated in the foyer, dedicated?

7. The Bereavement Support Group (BSG) usually makes contact about six weeks after a death. However I would like to speak to them now. How can I do this?
